

## **IKEBANA NORTH AMERICAN REGION WEBSITE POLICIES**

1. Only information for or about official Ikebana International chapters will be published.
2. North American Region chapter information will receive priority over information from other Ikebana International regions.
3. Articles about ikebana (flower arranging) will have priority over other Japanese cultural items.
4. Information about events in the next quarter has priority over events more than three months out.
5. An exception to #4 above is any information regarding future regional conferences.
6. Articles unrelated to ikebana or Japanese cultural arts are not acceptable.
7. Neither the editor nor the editorial board is responsible for the accuracy of published information.
8. Information on this website is not to be used for solicitation purposes nor is it to be resold without the expressed permission of the editorial board.
9. Requests to publish information received outside the due dates for publication will be considered on a case-by-case basis and are at the sole discretion of the newsletter editor.
10. Contact information within any North American chapter will be provided to any I.I. chapter member. Information requests from non-I.I. members will first be cleared by the editor through the respective chapter. Chapter contact information will not be provided directly to -non I.I. members.
11. Website links to Ikebana International North American chapters will be provided for websites that have been updated in the past six months. In addition, a link to our Ikebana International headquarter website will be provided.
12. International website links to Ikebana schools that are

taught in the North American Region will be provided. If a school does not have an international website in English, then one from the U.S. will be provided if available. Individual ikebana school chapter web links will not be provided at this time.
